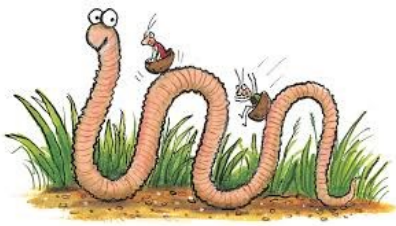
COMPETITION

FOX CLASS

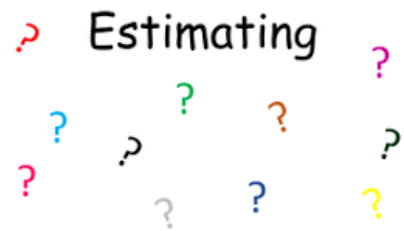


Next week we will be looking at Superworm and other minibeast books. Please bring in your favourites for us to read.

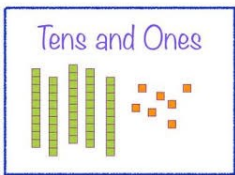
In Maths we will be measuring using non standard units and
