

Dear Parents,

We offer after school clubs for Year 1 and 2 children in the Autumn term, the information for booking places will be sent home next week. The children met Ryan, our new RAW football coach today in assembly, and next week they will meet our dance teacher, Hazel.

### Important information

The welfare of your children is always our primary concern. Please note the following important health and safety notices for the year:

- School starts at 8.50am and finishes at 3pm. The doors open at 8.50am and close at 8.55am when the register is then taken.
- If your child is too unwell to come to school and will be absent for the day please phone the school office by 9.15am. Messages can be left before 8.40am. If your child has a sickness or diarrhoea bug we follow NHS guidelines – please keep your child at home for 48 hours following the last bout of illness.
- Please notify the school office of any change of contact details for your family, including all those with parental responsibility and your additional contacts that we have on file for your child.
- If your usual collection arrangement for your child is different to the normal plan please sign the blue clipboard that each teacher has at the door in the morning. If the person collecting your child is unknown to us they will need to provide us with your password, please ensure they have your password.
- Playing in our woodland area and on our climbing frame is prohibited before and after school, this does also apply to visiting siblings. Riding of scooters and bikes is also prohibited on the playground. Drop off and collection times can be busy on our playground and we would hate for an accident to happen.

Thank you for your understanding and support in these matters.

We are excited about the coming year in school and look forward to working with you. If you have any concerns or worries please don't hesitate to speak to your child's class teacher or myself via the school office.
