Florence H (Class R) - For being a 'Go for it Gorilla' and being so enthusiastic at playing with our crates.

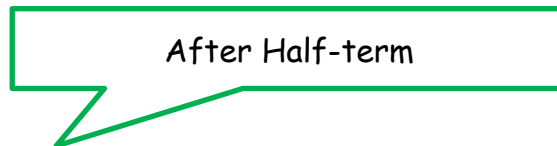
Florence T (Class R) - For super number ordering independently to 20.
