Fox Class

English – What would we do if the dinosaurs came back?

Maths – Estimating.

English – We will be planning and then writing our own non-chronological reports about castles! In phonics, we will be looking at alternative pronunciations of the grapheme 'y' (i, igh, ee). Our common exceptions words will be 'put', 'push', 'pull' and 'full'.

Maths – We will be comparing numbers by looking at the value of the tens and ones and will revisit the vocabulary of greater/smaller and more/fewer.

English – We will be reading a story and answering comprehension questions about it before imagining we are one of the characters and writing a diary about our day! Words of the week are: beautiful, steak, great, break.

Maths – We will be using bar models to solve addition and subtraction word problems.
